BOOKING CONDITIONS When making the booking on behalf of a child, you as the legal guardian are accepting these conditions on their behalf.

- 1. No refunds will be given, except where an event is cancelled by High Life Highland Active Schools. High Life Highland Active Schools reserves the right to cancel any event.
- 2. For some activities we request that children under 8 attend with a responsible adult. If this is the case it will be stated in the programme.
- 3. Where suitable clothing has been specified for an activity, it is for safety reasons and must be adhered to.
- 4. All events organised by High Life Highland Active Schools are covered by its public liability insurance for any claim of negligence attributable to High Life Highland Active Schools. Participants may wish to take out personal accident cover in addition to this.
- 5. High Life Highland Active Schools reserves the right to exclude people from any of its activities if they display any dangerous or inappropriate behaviour.
- 6. I am/my child is physically fit for the activity I have chosen.
- 7. I appreciate adventurous activities may be hazardous by their nature and I accept a reasonable element of risk.
- 8. My child is confident in the environment the activity takes place.
- 9. I confirm that my child can swim to the appropriate level to suit the activity they are being booked onto as stated in the programme (Note: this condition only relates to water based activities).
- 10. I agree to first aid/medical treatment being administered if required.
- 11. The contract shall be formed when the company acknowledges acceptance of the customers booking and required payment.
- 12. Participation in adventurous activities entails some risk of injury. All staff employed by the company are trained and appropriately qualified to run activity sessions and will at all times proceed in a manor to limit the risk of injury.
