Fort William – Young Learners take part in cooking sessions



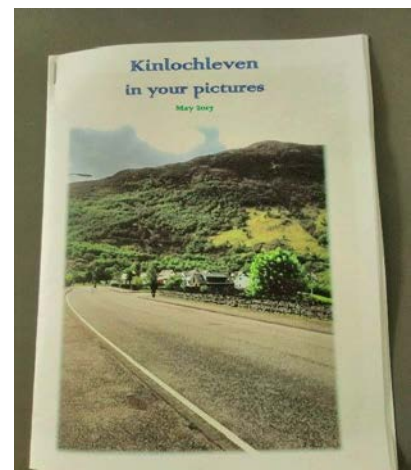
