Book Week Scotland

A total of 65 books were handed to Skye & Lochalsh Young Carers, Alzheimer Scotland, Portree Nursery and Kyleakin Connections. The ages of participants receiving the books ranged from 21 to 82!

One of our tutors delivered an interactive Origami Session helping another volunteer organisation imbed new ideas for implementing numeracy and literacy activities into their work.

The session illustrated how following instructions, using various coloured paper, measuring of paper, teaching shapes, helping one another, giving ideas for Christmas decorations and Card Making can be used as a Family Activity which encompasses learning in a fun and productive way.



Digital Skills Classes

Classes are being run in Portree & Kyleakin and we cover the Five Basic Digital Skills:

Managing Information; using websites and finding information online

Communicating; sending e-mails or online messaging services

Transacting; buying items via a website, buying and installing apps

Problem Solving; solving problems using online help

Creating; completing online application forms which include personal details.
