Key facts and stats

The Alness Youth Work Team has worked with 236 individual youngsters aged between 11 and 21 years amounting to 7161 meaningful contacts

In total there were approx 19,000 hours of engagement with young people

These were delivered on 416 separate occasions

These sessions took place in The Place, Alness Academy, residential projects, play scheme and trips away.

A total of 89 recognised awards were gained.

ROCK CHALLENGE

Alness Academy Rock Challenge is in its 6th year with over 100 young people taking part. Everyone on the team is fully committed from dancers, make -up and hair to costumes. They have now won at Inverness heats 4 years in a row and are off to Scottish Finals in Dundee again in June.

SPEAK

The SPEAK group is a group for young people that aims to raise awareness of mental health of all young people in the area. The focus of Speak group this year has been to raise funds for their mental health charities. The group have already done some fundraising, such as Giant Twister in The Place, Baking Sales and pancake making.

CHRISTMAS FAYRE 2015

A group of young people took on the challenge of organising a Christmas Fayre. From buying and wrapping presents, to setting up gazebos in the rain it was totally young person led. Santa and his reindeer also put in an appearance. The organising group were supported by members of the Youth Work Team.

LEADERSHIP PROGRAM

In partnership with Active Schools, a large number of young people signed up for the Leadership Programme. The programme is designed to encourage young people to take the lead in a variety of settings which can include Youth Work and Sport.
