A letter to Ewan MacPherson of Cluny from Prince Charles Edward Stuart, announcing the intention of setting up the Royal Standard at Glenfinnan, dated 6th August 1745.

It reads: 'Being Fully perswaded of your Loyalty and zeal of the Kings service I think fit to inform you that I am come unto this country to assert his right, at the head of such of his faithfull subjects as will engage in his quarrel. I intend therefor to set up the Royale Standard at Glenfinnen on munday the 19th instant. Your appearance on that occasion woud be very usfull: but if not practicable, I expect you to joyn me as soon as possible and you shall always find me ready to give you marks of my friendship. Charles P.R.'
