

**Warrant of Commitment against Archbald Chisolm for wearing a filibeg (kilt)
(GB0232/L/INV/SC/6a/1)**

At Inverness 10 October 1750 Archbald Chisolm in Glencanich of Strathgless having been convened before Alexr Monro Esqr Sheriff Substitute of Inverness for using the Feligbegg contrary to law the following judgement was given against the said Archbald Chisolm. The Sheriff having considered this complaint with the judicial acknowledgement of the said Archbald Chisolm complained on with the forgoing depositions and piece of plaid produced, finds the complaint proven and there for deems and adjudges the said Archbald Chisolm to be committed prisoner within the tolbooth of Inverness there to remain for the space of six months from this date without bail, and grants warrant to and requires the magistrates of Inverness and keepers of their tolbooth to receive and detain him accordingly.
