

NC1/13 Wick Police Occurrence Book

'P.C. George Gunn, Wick, reports the theft of one gents blue suit, one white muffler, one pair of boots, one white dressing shirt and a purse containing 9/3, on Monday 1st of June, 1914, from off the schooner "Gleanor" at that time lying in Wick Harbour.

Nels Anderson, owner of the above property went to bed on the said night about 8 pm and left Harry Cooper, who was the only other man on board, sitting in the same room. When Anderson awoke about 3 am on the following morning, he found that the above articles were amissing, and that Cooper had left, leaving his own clothing behind'
