'P.C. George Gunn, Wick, reports the theft of one gents blue suit, one white muffler, one pair of boots, one white dressing shirt and a purse containing 9/3, on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> of June, 1914, from off the schooner "Gleanor" at that time lying in wick Harbour.

Nels Anderson, owner of the above property went to bed on the said night about 8 pm and left Harry Cooper, who was the only other man on board, sitting in the same room. When Anderson awoke about 3 am on the following morning, he found that the above articles were amissing, and that Cooper had left, leaving his own clothing behind'
