

R91/D/C/5/21 24 Sept 1940 - Parachutist landing at Tulloch

24 Tuesday: At 10am cycled to Roybridge and Murlaggan. Made enquiry re spreading of false news regarding the landing of the parachutist at Tulloch. Noted statements from Mary Ann MacDonald (44) Post Mistress, Roybridge, James Cameron (14), telegraph messenger, the Gorge, Roybridge, William Mackintosh (58), Hotel, Roybridge, Murdoch Miller (50), Railway Surfaceman, Inveroy, and Alexander MacLaren (50), Railway Surfaceman, the Gorge, Roybridge. From enquiry made it appears that the telegraph messenger took a false message to the Postmistress who in turn reported to the Police Fort William that Germans had landed at Tulloch.

To Station at 2pm + was about the village + station till 6pm.
