Description

We offer customers access to archive collections across Highland. Personal information such as name, address, telephone number and email address is collected in order for us to;

- o Administer access to collections in our searchrooms
- Contact customers to respond to their enquiry
- o Give copyright permissions
- Collect dispositor information on Deposit Agreement Forms so that we retain a record of how the collection was acquired and from whom.

We also use the information collected for statistical purposes.

Conditions for processing personal information

Consent – article 6 (1)(a) - we require your personal information to allow us to provide access to collections in the searchroom and respond to your enquiry

Contract – article 6 (1)(b) - we need to process this personal information to fulfil our contract with the depositor of a collection
