Child Admissions Policy

- Carers or parents are responsible for the safe behaviour of their children.
- A responsible person is defined as someone aged 16 years of age or over and able to swim.
- Lifeguards cannot replace the care and attention of a carer or parent.
- Carers must remain in close proximity / contact with their children and ensure they are closely supervised at all times.
- Carers must keep children who are non-swimmers or weak swimmers within the shallow end of the pool.
