Following the election, the Labour Party and the Liberal Democrats formed the Scottish Executive, with Labour Member of the Scottish Parliament (MSP) Donald Dewar becoming First Minister.	
	The Scottish Parliament was created after a referendum on devolution took place on September 11, 1997 in which 74.3% of those who voted approved the idea. The Scotland Act (1998) was then passed by the UK Parliament which established the devolved Scottish parliament and Scottish Executive. The parliament was elected using Mixed member proportional representation
