Gunn is the author of several books including 'Caithness Castles', 'Historical Dictionary of the Albanian Tribes, Clans, and Families', and 'Sons of the Sword: a genealogical history of the Hereditary Chiefs of the Clan Gunn, descendants of the Pictish Mormaers of Catt, the Viking Jarls of Orkney/Caithness, and the Hereditary Crowners of Caithness'.
