RECORDS' CONTEXT

Name of creators: Harry and Margaret (Peggy) Barrett; various

Administrative history: Harry Barrett was born in Margate in 1919 and following in his family's maritime trades, joined the Royal Navy at 15 years old. His naval career led him to work in the Fleet Air Arm division aboard the aircraft carrier HMS Ark Royal. After the ship docked in Scapa Flow Harry travelled to Wick airport with some of the aircraft from the Ark Royal during Winter 1939.

Peggy was born in Wick in 1916, the second child of a family of four. During WWII Peggy was on a committee that organised local dances for service personnel. This was how she met Harry and their first date was sledging down Harbour Road which led to Harry's only uniform being soaked. Peggy took him back to the family home to dry off.

When told of a posting to Freetown in West Africa Harry proposed to Peggy by letter from Scapa Flow and she accepted. They married two weeks later in April 1939. It was the first wartime wedding in Wick and the town turned out to watch. They were married for over 65 years.

Harry left the navy when their first child was born and joined the police force, eventually being stationed in Caithness.

While living in Thurso Peggy became a Town Councillor and then a County Councillor. She held the position of Chairwoman of the

Townswomen's Guild and gained a long service medal for her membership of WRVS (Women's Royal Voluntary Service). Peggy's voluntary work continued in Inverness where the family moved after Harry got transferred with the police force.
