RECORDS' CONTEXT

Name of creators: **Donald James Mackay**

Donald James Mackay was born and Administrative history:

raised in Thurso. Caithness.

Donald had a keen interest in football. playing for local Thurso Football Team 'The Swifts', of which his father James G. Mackay was President. Donald retained a 'Swifts' tie from his own

playing days.

After his military service Donald played trombone with Thurso Town Band. Donald always signed his name D.J. Mackay.

Donald retained many photographs of his extensive Naval service during World War Two and through them and the names of the ships it is possible to ascertain some of his naval service history.

Donald's initial training began with a 10 week training course at H.M.S. Collingwood in Fareham, Hampshire. The base was built specifically to train Naval ratings for 'hostilities only', that is the duration of war only.

H.M.S Erebus was Donald's first posting after leaving H.M.S

Collingwood. Serving as part of the Fastern Fleet and the Pacific Fleet the

ship was involved in various operations. A monitor class of ship, Erebus was a smaller warship with shallow draught to allow operations close to shore. Armed with large calibre 15inch guns they provided coastal bombardment for land operations including the D Day landings on 6 Jun 1944 and against the defenders of the harbour of Le Havre on 10 Aug 1944

Donalds next posting was to serve onboard H.M.S Chaser, an Attacker class Escort aircraft Carrier which was transferred to the Royal Navy from the US Navy in April 1943. She served to protect the Russian convoy trade route before being allocated to the British Pacific Fleet. H.M.S Chaser served as a replenishment carrier supporting frontline aircraft carriers with supplies. replacement aircraft and ammunition while at sea. Departing Glasow in January 1945 she sailed through the Suez Canal, arriving in Australia in June 1945 where her pennant number was changed to R306 signifying Pacific operations.

The ship was in the Pacific when the Japanese surrendered on 2 Sep 1945 and involved in transporting allied prisoners of war back home.

On leaving the Royal Navy Donald married and settled in Thurso, working in the wages office in Dounreay. Later Donald changed work, moving to the Superannuation Office in Tollemache House in Thurso, before retiring.
