Administrative history: Christian Couper (or Cowper) was born

Christian Campbell and was baptised at Clyth on 11 May 1765. Christian married Robert Couper, a shoemaker from Thurso, in 1783. The initial entries from her midwifery memorandum book for 1786 detail babies born in Edinburgh, suggesting she was taught midwifery

there.

Christian's memorandum book records that she assisted at the birth of 3,948 babies across Caithness, serving both the very rich and the very poor

throughout the county. Christian also had eleven children of her own: Donald (b.1784), Helen (b.1787), Isabel (b.1788), Hannah (b.1789), Donald (b.1792),

Catherine (b.1798), Christian (b.1800), Christian (b.1802), Elizabeth (b.1804).

Alexander (b.1794), Robert (b.1796),

Christian died on 29 Apr 1843 in Thurso. Her obituary in the John O'Groat Journal reads 'Died – At Thurso, on the 30th ult. Mrs Couper, midwife, aged 79. Mrs C. had exercised her vocation for more than half-a-century; and her list of children amounts to about 4000, and a mother never died in her hands. Her services to the poor were always given cheerfully

and gratuitously, although patronised by all the gentry in the county. Her death leaves a blank in the obstetrick profession that will not easily be filled up. The deceased was sister to the late Chief Justice of Canada, Sir W. Campbell'.

(Cowper's) Midwife Memorandum Book is held by the National Records of Scotland (previously the General Register Office

for Scotland) in Edinburgh.
