RECORDS' CONTEXT

Name of creators:	Highland Regional Council
Administrative history:	<p>Highland Region was constituted under the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 and existed from May 1975 until March 1996.</p> <p>It replaced five former County Councils (Caithness, Sutherland, Ross and Cromarty, Inverness and Nairn) and its boundaries took in part of Moray (Grantown on Spey Burgh and Cromdale district) and Argyll (Ardnamurchan district and Ballachulish and Kinlochleven electoral divisions). Altogether it became the largest local government unit in western Europe with an area of 2,513,000 ha. (9,700 square miles).</p> <p>The old County Councils of Caithness, Sutherland, Ross & Cromarty, Inverness and Nairn were replaced by a two-tier system: the Highland Regional Council, and eight District Councils (including Caithness).</p> <p>The Regional Council was responsible for education, roads and transport, social work, water and sewerage, planning, economic and industrial development, the European Community, consumer protection and trading standards, libraries and leisure services.</p> <p>The functions of police, fire service, valuation and electoral registration were</p>

exercised through Joint Committees with the adjoining island authorities.

District Councils were responsible for housing, environmental services, local licensing and shared with the Region powers over recreational and leisure provision and industrial development.

In 1996 the Highland Regional Council and the eight District Councils were replaced by The Highland Council.

	<p>committed to the fast reactor, thereby making best use of all the available expertise and technical facilities.</p> <p>Within the UK, the government believed that no site could lay such a powerful claim for consideration as Dounreay which had been successfully and safely reprocessing plutonium fuels for many years and was considered a world leader in the development of the necessary technology. Importantly, there was sufficient capacity for further development on UKAEA-owned land adjacent to the existing licensed site. The government was also aware that over the thirty years it had been established a very good relationship had developed with the local community; it also employed over 2,000 people, making it by far the largest employer in the area, and further expansion would probably be welcomed.</p> <p>It was also felt that the infrastructure of the area – railway, road and airport facilities – had the capacity for further expansion to cope with traffic of all types.</p> <p>An important element, although not alluded to, was that a successful outcome would almost certainly give Britain, and Dounreay, a vital advantage should there be an eventual need for an EDRP.</p> <p>The stakes were therefore high when the Public Inquiry opened in the Town Hall, Thurso, on 7th April 1986. The Inquiry ran until 19 November 1986, making it the longest Public Inquiry to be held in Scotland. It included a two-day session in Kirkwall, and a one-and-a-half-day session in Invergordon. This report confirmed that there appeared to be a higher incidence of leukaemia in young people residing within the (Sellafield) area but with the caveat that the estimated radiation dose from Sellafield could not account for the observed leukaemia incidence on the basis of available knowledge. In respect of the COMARE Report, Mr Rifkind formed the view that it did not contain new evidence representing a significant advance over which was available to the Inquiry.</p> <p>By the time the Secretary of State announced the outcome some years later, however, it was academic. Britain had pulled the plug on its own fast reactor programme, so there was no prospect of the plant being built to reprocess the European fast reactor being built there. As it turned out, no country has built the fast reactors either.</p>
