Car Parking:

There is a large free car park to the right-hand side of the library location opposite the main entrance to the local community centre.

There are two designated disabled parking spaces marked out, with signage, adjacent to the side wall of the library building in the car park.

Public Transport:

Regular A9 daily bus service to the North and South areas, (Wick / Inverness), pass through the village.

Railway Station

Local bus service to and from the village three times daily – route covers Golspie, Brora and the Helmsdale area.

Additional information

In November 2012 Golspie Library underwent temporary closure in order for both exterior and interior work to take place. This resulted in a new exterior roof for the library area of the building and newly painted walls and floor covering for the library interior.
