

**Letter by Ewan Brodie to Hester Cameron RE: the death of Allan Cameron,
1914
(GB0232/D766/17/2/12)**

27.9.14

Dear Hester,

I fear I have very bad news for you, I must write it in a word as we have not a moment, & I will write fuller later. Dear Allan, with Meirs, Napier, Cameron, Meiklejohn and Crockett were all killed on 25th instantaneously by a huge shell bursting on the top of a trench in which they were. They are buried in the church yard of BOURG, and I have had a stone, with names engraved, erected over their graves & the name in paint on wood at the head of each. Each one is separate but one big grave. I enclose name of sculptor, who knows the position of graves. Dear Allan, I do miss him & do so feel for you.
