


HOW TO LOG IN TO PRESSREADER ON A WEB BROWSER:




From the www.pressreader.com home page, select Sign In from the top right hand corner of the page to open the following window;

PERSONALISE YOUR PRESSREADER

Whilst you can use the PressReader without creating a personal account, the experience is further improved if you 'MakeItMine'.

To create a personal account in PressReader select **Sign Up** from the top right hand side of the PressReader page.


Complete the email address and select a password of your choice.

Add your name

Select your preferred communication permissions

Select Create My Account

To use your new account open the PressReader page and this time **Sign In** from the top righthand side of the page.

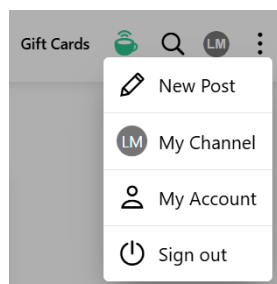

Please note: if you are using a public computer you do not want to stay signed in, as the next person will be automatically taken into your personal PressReader account – so ensure this box is not ticked.


HOW TO RE-REGISTER EVERY 30 DAYS – ON A WEB BROWSER:

To ensure continued free access to the PressReader service, you need to log out and re-register your access to the library's license every 30 days (This is for security purposes).



To sign out, go to the little circle containing your initials in the top right hand corner, and select Sign Out. This takes you back to the original PressReader home page.

Click Sign In from the top right hand of the page.

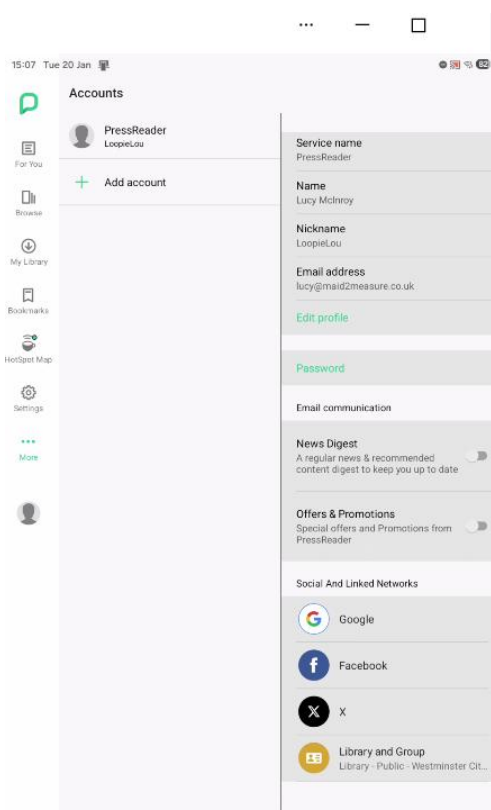



If you have created your own PressReader account, you will see your email on the right of this box. Ignore this, re-registering your library card is different to logging into your personal PressReader account.

Instead, click on the blue 'Library or Group' button and follow the steps to find your library and add your library card number and pin.

You will notice that the mustard coloured line on the welcome box now says 30 days again. The PressReader remembers you and takes you straight into your personalised PressReader account.

HOW TO RE-REGISTER EVERY 30 DAYS – ON THE APP:



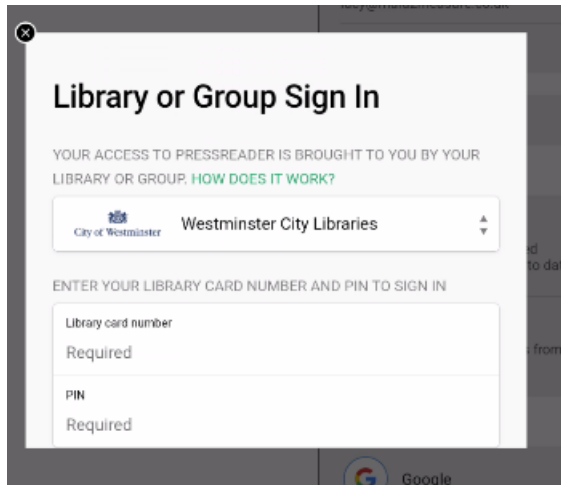
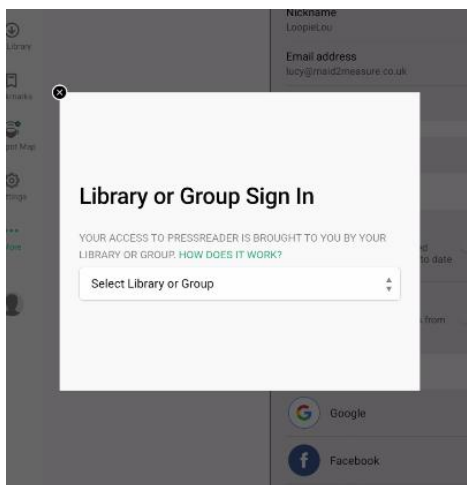
Click on the circular head at the bottom of the left hand menu to see all your account details.

Select the 'Library and Group' option found at the bottom of the right hand list.



Select to 'Unlink' your account

Select your library and add your library card and pin to re-register the card.
