Car parking:

The Phipps Institute has its own car park, with one designated disabled parking space located close to the main entrance.

Public transport:

The main bus stop is approximately a 2-minute walk from the library, and the train station is about a 10-minute walk away.

Additional information

The main entrance is equipped with an automatic door, while access to the library is via a manual door. There are no steps to negotiate.

A ladies' public restroom is situated in the foyer immediately outside the library, and a men's restroom is located on the first floor. Wheelchair-accessible facilities are available elsewhere within the building.
