Car parking:

There are two designated disabled parking bays located adjacent to the library, along with general parking spaces nearby for other vehicles..

Public transport:

Bus services run to Keppoch Road and Barn Church Road. The nearest bus stops are approximately 2 to 5 minutes' walk from the library.

Additional information:

Press-button automatic doors and ramped access for easy entry. Dual-height enquiry counter to accommodate all users. Built-in T-loop system available for those with hearing aids. The entire library is located on the ground floor, ensuring step-free access throughout. Toilets: Male, female, and accessible toilets are available for public use.
