Car parking:

A large, free car park is located to the right of the library, opposite the main entrance to the local community centre.

There are two designated disabled parking spaces, clearly marked with signage, adjacent to the side wall of the library building within this car park.

A local bus service operates three times daily, covering Golspie, Brora, and the Helmsdale area.
